After successfully completing four years of undergraduate study at Jincheng College, you can progress to postgraduate study at Manchester Metropolitan University. This is our 4+1 programme.

With our 4+1 programme, you can choose to pursue one year of postgraduate study, or one year of postgraduate study plus a further placement year. After successfully completing your postgraduate study, you can graduate with an award from Manchester Metropolitan University.

This programme gives you the opportunity to study at one of the largest research-led science and technology educators in the UK, offering high-quality postgraduate programmes across specialist departments.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

In order to study at Manchester Metropolitan University, you need to have completed four years of undergraduate study at Jincheng College and achieved an overall average score of 70 or above across all the subjects you have studied.

You also need to obtain a recognised English language qualification, such as IELTS, with a score of 6.5 or above, with no less than 5.5 in any element.

To study our MSc Project Management (Mechanical Engineering) and MSc Project Management (Electronic Engineering) courses, you need to have a score of 6.5 or above with reading, and 6.5 or above with writing 6.5. No subject can be below 6.0.

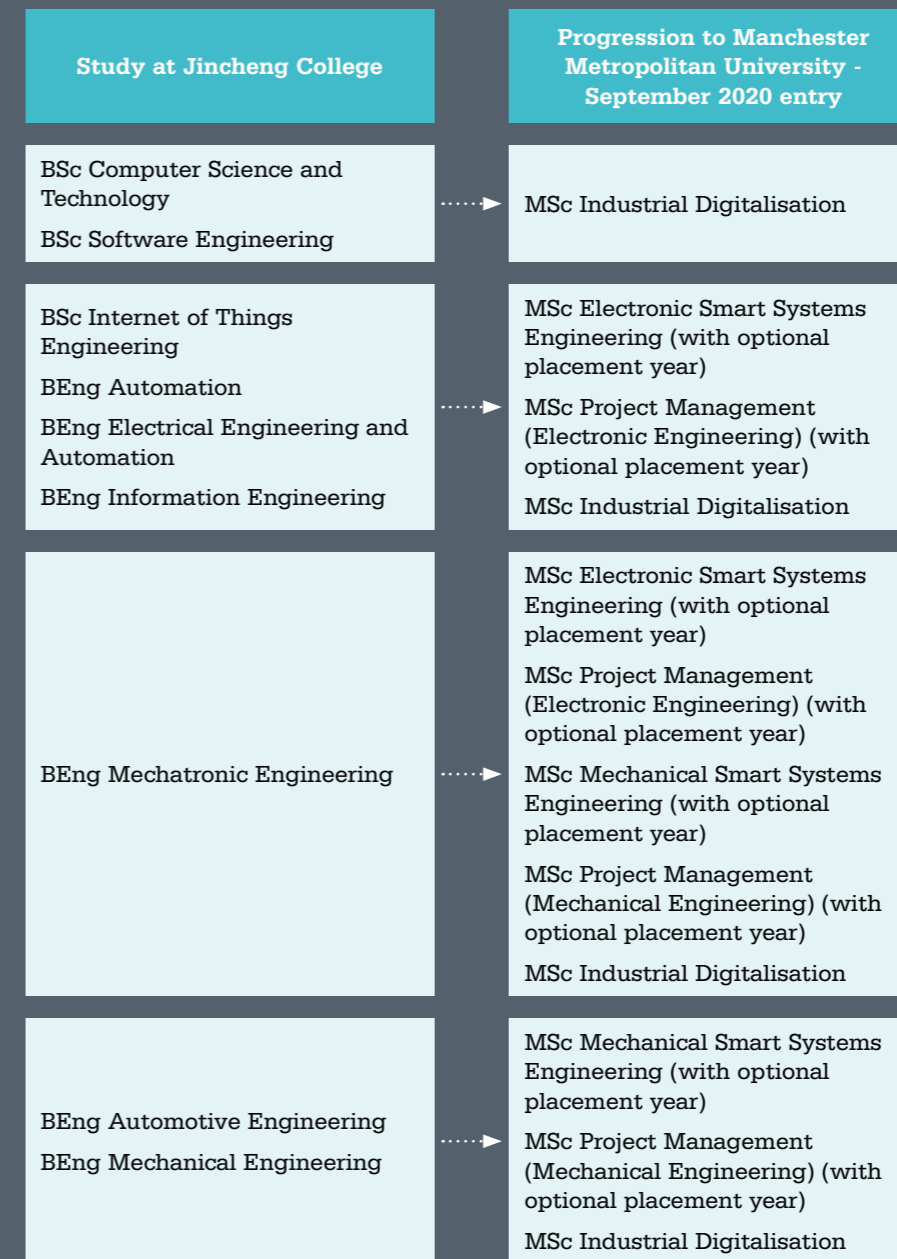
If you obtained an IELTS score below 6.5, you are also eligible to apply. If your application is successful, you will be required to attend a compulsory pre-session English course before you can begin your studies.

SCHOLARSHIPS

We offer a range of scholarships to help you pursue international study. Once you have been accepted onto your progression course, you are guaranteed to receive a £2,000 scholarship for your postgraduate study year(s).

International students can also apply for the Dalton International Scholarship. Worth £5,000**, this scholarship recognises future leaders in science and engineering.
